

Our school vision, values and EYFS aims	<p><b>Aspirational</b> We want our children to arrive at school each day with a big smile on their faces! Therefore we will spend this half term creating bonds and helping them to adapt to and enjoy school life through a phased timetable. Reception children will begin phonics and maths inputs from Week 2. Nursery children will also have a daily phonics and maths input. We will take part in National Poetry week and learn stories and poems for our Harvest Festival.</p> <p><b>Loving</b> By learning about our similarities and differences we will learn how to respect ourselves and each other. Also, to respect our new classroom and keep it tidy!</p>	<p><b>Aspirational</b> We will be learning about different religious festivals, this knowledge will help us to better understand and respect the beliefs of different faiths. Learning about festivals and other cultures will introduce us to some interesting new vocabulary such as 'diya lamp' and 'dreidel'.</p> <p><b>Loving</b> On 11/11 we will commemorate Armistice Day to respect the sacrifices the armed forces make for us.</p> <p>In Jigsaw, we will learn about people's similarities and differences and how to be kind to others.</p> <p><b>Resilient</b></p>	<p><b>Aspirational</b> We will talk about our hopes and dreams and what jobs we would like to do. We will learn about different jobs that people do and how people follow their dreams. We will think about how we can make our dreams come true as part of Make your dreams come true day!</p> <p><b>Loving</b> We will think about how we can be loving to our friends and how we can be superheroes to others and our community.</p> <p><b>Resilient</b> As part of national Storytelling week we will learn a range of stories and think of our own stories to perform to others.</p>	<p><b>Aspirational</b> In FS, we love to read! We will be engaging in lots of book related activities as part of our World Book Day celebrations.</p> <p>We will be forming lots of questions and predictions as part of our Science Week activities</p> <p><b>Loving</b> By learning about famous Scientists, we will have more respect for their achievements and inventions which have made our lives safer and easier. As part of Fairtrade Fortnight, we will learn to respect our food and the people that grow it.</p>	<p><b>Aspirational</b> We will learn about plants and different holiday destinations. Our Holidays theme will inspire lots of imaginative storytelling and role play opportunities. We will think about where we would like to go on holiday.</p> <p><b>Loving</b> Earth Day celebrations will give us an opportunity to consider how we can respect, care for and be kind to our planet.</p> <p><b>Resilient</b> We will work together to get plants to grow and we will learn how to explore the great outdoors safely during our Forest School days. We will learn how</p>	<p><b>Aspirational</b> We will prepare ourselves for Year 1 and share our worries and the things we are excited for. We will set up simple investigations about plants and the weather.</p> <p><b>Loving</b> We will draw and write about our favourite qualities of our friends. We will learn about the armed forces through armed forces week.</p> <p><b>Resilient</b> By learning about Child Safety week we will learn how to keep ourselves safe. There's no doubt that healthiness and happiness are interlinked. We will explore how we can care for our bodies and minds through exercise, healthy eating and breathwork.</p>

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	<p>Children will learn what behaviours are expected of them to keep them safe in their new school environment.</p> <p><b>Resilient</b> We will have our first trip and learn how to keep safe away from our classroom environment. We will complete our first full days in the classroom, we understand it can be tiring and will learn strategies to help us when we miss our parents.</p>	<p>During Road Safety week we will learn how to keep ourselves safe when crossing the road. We will have a visit from the fire service to talk to us about fire safety and keeping safe on Bonfire night. We will develop the skill of resilience through our hard work on our Nativity performance.</p>	<p>We will investigate different materials and use our skills of resilience to build dens and houses.</p>	<p><b>Resilient</b> We will work together to do surveys of the cars/vehicles in our village. Our EYFS curriculum	<p><b>All About Me</b> This half term our focus will be on getting to know each and exploring what makes each of us special and unique. We will learn how to keep healthy and about basic hygiene.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> As well as becoming valued members of our class, we will be welcomed into our school community. We will be introduced to staff who work across the school.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> We will learn about Harvest and prepare something to share as part of our Harvest Festival. We will visit our church to take part in our school harvest festival. How do fire fighters help the community? We will invite members of the local fire service to talk about their job.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> Our world is full of incredible people! We will learn about how the Great Fire of London changed our lives. We will begin to celebrate Black History month and learn about remarkable people who have changed our world such as Katherine Johnson and Mae Jemison.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> We will observe seasonal changes and signs of Autumn. We will go on hunts for the changes and collect autumn objects.</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b> To strengthen our friendships in our class we will learn some new sharing and turn taking games.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> We will learn our parts and perform in the school Nativity.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> By singing carols and visiting the church, FS will spread Christmas cheer in our village community.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> We will learn about our country and the parts of the world. We will 'travel' the world and celebrate different religious festivals such as Diwali (Hinduism) and Hannukah (Judaism). We will also explore how Christmas is celebrated around the world and make comparisons with how we celebrate it in the UK.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> An FS Christmas will aim to be a sustainable Christmas. We will create our own decorations from natural or recycled materials.</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b> We will celebrate small acts of kindness by introducing the children to our 'kindness tree'.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> We will think about the superheroes in our school and how we can say thank you to them for their help.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> We will think about the superheroes in our local community. We will create cards to say thank you.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> Our world is full of incredible people! We will learn about inspirational heroes in our world. We will think about materials used for building across the world and why houses are built as they are.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> Through taking part in the 'Big Garden Bird Watch', we will learn about the challenges our wildlife face in Winter and how we can help them. We will create some bird houses using recycled materials.</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b> This half term we will learn about good oral hygiene/being healthy from a nurses visit.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> We will draw maps of our school and local area.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> We will invite KS2 children to work with us in their roles as Reading Ambassadors to inspire a love of reading.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> We will learn about the important places in our community. At All Saint's Church we will celebrate Easter with Rev James and we will invite our family and friends to our school Easter Eggstravaganza.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> We will learn about where our village is in the wider world.</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b> We will learn about our holidays and favourite places to visit.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> We will work alongside the rest of the school to keep our gardens tidy for summer.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> We will learn about holidays in the past and how they have changed. We will ask members of the community to share their childhood memories.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> Where in the world is Eid celebrated? We will find out and ask members of our local Muslim community to share how they celebrate the end of Ramadan. We will think about the places we can go on holiday and how we would travel there.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> Spring will arrive this half term! We will observe the changes this season brings and mark the Japanese festival of 'hanami'.</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b> We will think about how we have changed. We will explore the weather's we like the most and why.</p> <p><b>Our School</b> We will work with the other members of our house team to participate in our sports day. We will look at the weather during a school day and how it changes.</p> <p><b>Our Community</b> We will enjoy taking part in our community Strawberry Fayre and we will do some weather surveys in our community.</p> <p><b>Our World</b> We will visit the seaside as part of our holidays theme. We will learn about popular holiday destinations and where in the world they are. We will discuss weather across the world.</p> <p><b>Our Planet</b> Summer is the time to enjoy the fruits of our labour and eat some of our home grown produce. We will think about the sea and how we can look after our sea and environment.</p>
